MAIN DUTIES & RESPONSIBILITIES

- Maximise uptime and availability of manufacturing equipment.
- Provide effective equipment and process support to operators and staff.
- Plan downtime activities to achieve equipment efficiency KPIs.
- Evaluate new equipment and manufacturing processes.
- Report KPIs to the Production Manager in line with company objectives.
- Work with systems to maximize uptime and equipment performance and efficiency.
- Take part in maintenance team improvement projects.
- Undertake maintenance and improvements to the building and facilities.
- Carry out planned maintenance routines and servicing of equipment.
- Install new equipment and provide services to such equipment.
- Liaise with contractors or other engineering services as required.
- Work with machine setters to ensure repeatability of the process and assembly.
- Organise and procure equipment spares and services.

- Experienced in working and fault-finding on PLC controlled equipment.
- Experienced with pneumatic and hydraulic systems, conveying systems, drives and pumps.
